- Applications shall include two (2) letters of recommendation (e.g. professors, instructors, principals, deans, employers, personal acquaintances, etc.). It is highly recommended that these letters originate from academic department members, school officials, or teachers of classes related to your postsecondary major.
- Please attach an electronic copy of college / trade / technical / high school transcript or most recent grade report. Unofficial transcripts issued by an educational institution are acceptable.
- Selection criteria for this scholarship are as follows: financial need, academic relationship to the building industry, quality of application, grade point average and community service / extracurricular involvement / work experience.
- Applications must be submitted no later than April 25, 2022.
